ROBERT LANGDON

A fierce advocate for his clients, trial attorney [Bob Langdon](#) has been recognized as one of the top personal injury litigators in the country, having successfully tried cases from coast-to-coast on behalf of plaintiffs.

For more than 30 years, Bob has devoted his practice to representing individuals and their families in cases where defective vehicles or products have caused serious injury or death. Bob has actively pursued the world's largest corporations for causing deaths and serious injuries to innocent Americans.

Described as a “natural” in the courtroom, Bob has served as lead counsel in some of the nation's significant personal injury trials and has obtained multi-million dollar verdicts on behalf of clients nationwide.
